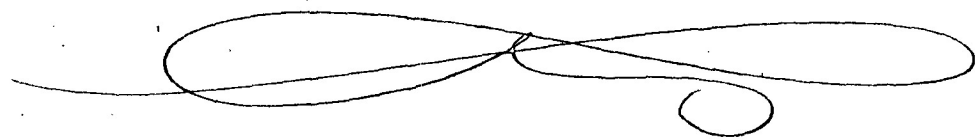

JAMES MADISON, President of the United States of America,
TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, Greeting:

KNOW YE, That *Joseph Hedges, Philip Shartle, and John Augustus, Assignees of Peter Parcells,*

having deposited in the General Land-office a certificate of the register of the Land-office at *Chillicothe,* whereby it appears that full payment has been made for the *South West quarter of Section thirty-five, of Township twelve, in Range twenty,*



of the lands directed to be sold at *Chillicothe,* by the act of Congress, entitled "An act providing for the sale of the lands of the United States in the territory north-west of the Ohio, and above the mouth of Kentucky river," and of the acts amendatory of the same: **There is granted,** by the United States, unto the said *Joseph Hedges, Philip Shartle & John Augustus,* the *quarter* lot or section of land above described: **To have and to hold** the said *quarter* lot or section of land, with the appurtenances, unto the said *Joseph Hedges, Philip Shartle & John Augustus,* their heirs and assigns forever, as *tenants in common, and not as joint tenants.*

In Testimony whereof, I have caused these letters to be made **Patent,** and the seal of the General Land-office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand at the City of Washington, the *twenty-first* day of *September,* in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and *fifteen,* and of the Independence of the United States of America, the *fortieth.*
