JAMES MADISON, President of the United States of America, TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, Greeting:

KNOW YE, That Joseph Hedges, Philip Shartle, and John Augustus, Asignees of Peter Parcels,

having deposited in the General Land-office a certificate of the register of the Land-office at Chillieothe, whereby it appears that full payment has been made for the South West quarter of Section thirty-five, of Township twelve, in Range twenty,

by the act of Congress, entitled "An act providing for the sale of the lands of the United States in the territory north-west of the Ohio, and above the mouth of Kentucky river," and of the acts amendatory of the same: States is stately, by the United States, unto the said Joseph Headges Philip thartle Yohn a Auguster the quarter or section of land above described: So state atto to sold the said quarter lot or section of land, with the appurtenances, unto the said Joseph Headges, Philip thartle typhn Augustus, their heirs and assigns forever, as tenants in common, and not as joint tenants.
